# CLAUDETTE CHARNEY HEAD COACH



Head coach Claudette Charney begins her third season at the helm of the Charger women's basketball program.

In her first season as head coach, Charney guided the Chargers to their best record in school history (23-6), while leading Hillsdale to its second appearance ever in the NCAA Tournament. In addition, she helped Hillsdale earn its second straight GLIAC South Division title with a school record 14-3 conference record, while also guiding senior Stephanie Heid to two All-American honors in 2002-

Charney has posted five NCAA Tournament and four NAIA Tournament appearances throughout her career, which includes Alma, Saginaw Valley, Grand Valley and Hillsdale. She led her GVSU team to consecutive 23 win seasons in 1998 and 1999, the first time in the school's basketball history. In 1998, the Lakers won the GLIAC North Division championship with a 15-3 mark in league play. She was named the GLIAC Women's Basketball Coach of the Year in 1987 and 1998, and the NCAA District IV Coach of the Year in 1998.

In 1986 and 1987, Charney led Saginaw Valley to the GLIAC Championship and in 1993 the Cardinals earned a berth in the "Sweet 16" during the national tournament. Charney currently ranks 35th



03. She followed up her first season with a 10-16 record in 2003-04, playing seven freshman regularly.

Charney, who was hired in May of 2002, has experience in the conference that is unmatched serving over 19 years as a head coach in the GLIAC. Charney spent seven seasons at Grand Valley State (1995-2002), compiling a 102-89 overall record in that span. Previous to GVSU, she spent 10 seasons at Saginaw Valley State, compiling a 196-92 record. She also spent one year at Alma College and three years as head coach at Muskegon Community College.

Charney has been in the collegiate coaching ranks for over 19 years, posting an overall record of 339-193 in 19 seasons at four-year institutions.

# ASSISTANT COACH TRACY BRUNO



Tracy Bruno begins her first season as an assistant coach at Hillsdale. Bruno is no stranger to Hillsdale as this is her second stint as an assistant women's basketball coach for the Chargers. Bruno previously served as an assistant at Hillsdale under former coach Dana Munk from 1998-2001. In that time, HC posted a 47-36 overall record with a 31-24 conference mark in three seasons. The Chargers advanced to GLIAC Tournament play all three seasons she coached there.

Following Hillsdale, Bruno was an admissions advisor for Baker College in Clinton Twp. (2003-04) and a Fitness Specialist for The Industrial Athlete from 2001-03.

She earned her master's degree from Eastern Michigan University in December 2003 (graduated with honors). She graduated with honors from Saginaw Valley State University in 1994 with a bachelor of arts degree. As an undergraduate, Bruno was a five-year member of the women's basketball team under now current Hillsdale head coach Claudette Charney. She was named to the All-Conference and All-Defensive team, along with the GLIAC All-Academic Team. The Cardinals competed in the NCAA Tournament her junior year.

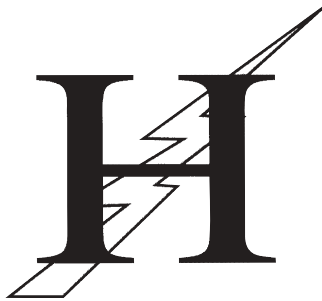
