WEEK 7 - HILLSDALE CELEBRATES HOMECOMING vs. TOP-RANKED LAKERS

It is Homecoming this weekend at Hillsdale College, and the Charger football team will host #1 Grand Valley State University for a 2:30 p.m. kickoff.

THE SERIES

This is the 32nd all-time meeting between Hillsdale and Grand Valley State. The Lakers have won 10 in a row over the Chargers and hold a 22-9 lead in the all-time series.

RADIO GAGA

Andy Brown and Jim Eckhardt will handle the play-by-play duties on WCSR 92.1-FM, live from the Muddy Waters Stadium press box.

FOLLOW THE CHARGERS ONLINE

There are two other ways for fans to follow Charger football. Live stats are available for all home games, courtesy of PrestoSports. Real-time play-by-play and statistical screens are available through the free service, as well as a GLIAC scoreboard. In addition, B2Networks provides webcasting for all Hillsdale College home football games. Check the Hillsdale College athletic website for the links.

PRE-SEASON ACCOLADES

A handful of players have earned preseason accolades from various magazines and websites. Senior DE **Drew Berube** was named the Preseason Division II Defensive Player of the Year by the Consensus Draft Services. That same organization named Berube, TE **Matt Patillo** and OL **Jared Veldheer** to its preseason All-American lists.

D2football.com named Veldheer, Berube and PK **Mark Petro** to its preseason First-Team All-American list. Only Northwest Missouri State had as many as three players on that website's preseason All-American Team.

PRO PROSPECT

Jared Veldheer is rated as the No. 4 pro prospect according to D2football.com. Veldheer is the highest-rated GLIAC player on the website's list. Some of the NFL scouting services have Veldheer projected as a fourth-round draft pick.

BACK HOME

The Chargers are coming off their first set of back-to-back road games since Oct. 22-29, 2005. Hillsdale defeated nationally ranked Ashland 38-19 on Sept. 26 before losing at Findlay last week, 42-17. After playing four of its first six games on the road, Hillsdale will play in the friendly confines of Frank "Muddy" Waters Stadium in three of its final five games of the 2009 season.

A SWIFT KICK IN THE PETRO

Senior PK **Mark Petro** has ranked among the nation's top kickers over the past two years, and is now in rare company in school history among players at his position. He now holds Hillsdale's all-time record for extra-points made with 135. His 44 field goals made in his career are second all-time to Rick Vear's 49, and Petro's 220 career points are second in school history among kickers, only trailing Charger Hall-of-Famer Chester Marcol. Petro is currently third in Division II with 2.0 field goals per game, and

SECOND-GENERATION CHARGERS

Part of the great tradition of Hillsdale College football comes in the generations of players who have suited up for the Chargers. The 2009 team has three players who all had fathers that played at Hillsdale. QB **Brad Otterbein** (father Keith), DB **Joe Vear** (father Rick), and QB **Anthony Mifsud** (father David) all represent a second generation of Hillsdale College football players within their own families.

HAPPY HOMECOMINGS

In recent years, Homecoming games have ended happily for the Chargers. Under head coach Keith Otterbein, the Chargers are 6-1 on Homecoming, including five straight victories in such games. Some of the games have been thrillers, like the 38-31 overtime win over Gannon in 2004, and the come-from-behind classic, 14-13 over Indianapolis in 2006. Hillsdale's last loss on Homecoming came on Oct. 18, 2003, when it lost a 34-31 overtime game against Northwood.

WHEN WE LAST SAW THE CHARGERS...

Hillsdale saw its three-game winning streak against the University of Findlay come to an end, as the Oilers topped the Chargers in Ohio, 42-17.

VINNIE, VIDI, VICI!

Senior RB **Vinnie Panizzi** is placing his name among the all-time best running backs in Charger history. He has 2,995 career rushing yards, and with five yards in this game, will become the third player in school history with 3,000 rushing yards in his career. He also has 40 career rushing touchdowns, which ranks third on the school's career list. Only Nate Clark (51) and Scott Schulte (46) lead Panizzi in that category. This season, he has 779 rushing yards, which is No. 7 in the nation.

DOWNRIGHT OFFENSIVE

Dating back to the final game of the 2006 season, the Charger offense has scored 30 or more points in 20 out of the past 29 games. During those 28 games, Hillsdale has produced 12 300-yard passing games, 12 100-yard rushing games and 16 100-yard receiving games by individual players.

NO MORAL VICTORIES

Dating back to the beginning of the 2007 season, seven of the Chargers' nine losses have come by seven points or less.

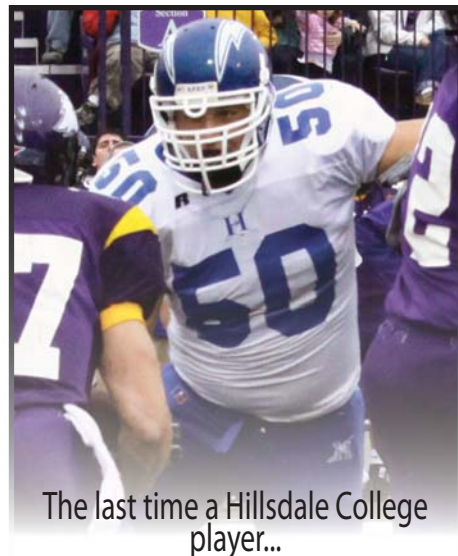
