WEEK 8 - CHARGERS MAKE LONGEST ROAD TRIP OF THE SEASON

This week, the Hillsdale College football team makes the 10-hour drive north to Marquette to take on Northern Michigan University starting at 1 p.m.

THE SERIES

This is the 38th meeting all time between these schools, and the Chargers hold a 22-14-1 advantage over the Wildcats in the series. Hillsdale has won two in a row over NMU, scoring a total of 91 points in those two games.

PRE-SEASON ACCOLADES

A handful of players have earned preseason accolades from various magazines and websites. Senior DE **Drew Berube** was named the Preseason Division II Defensive Player of the Year by the Consensus Draft Services. That same organization named Berube, TE **Matt Patillo** and OL **Jared Veldheer** to its preseason All-American lists.

D2football.com named Veldheer, Berube and PK **Mark Petro** to its preseason First-Team All-American list. Only Northwest Missouri State had as many as three players on that website's preseason All-American Team.

PRO PROSPECT

Jared Veldheer is rated as the No. 4 pro prospect according to D2football.com. Veldheer is the highest-rated GLIAC player on the website's list. Some of the NFL scouting services have Veldheer projected as a fourth-round draft pick.

HISTORIC WIN

Last week, the Hillsdale College football team won a game fans of the Chargers will be talking about for a long time. Hillsdale defeated previously unbeaten and No. 1 Grand Valley State 27-24 at Frank "Muddy" Waters Stadium. The win ended the Lakers' 45-game GLIAC winning streak and was the first regular season game lost by GVSU since October 2004. It was also Hillsdale's first win over Grand Valley since Oct. 15, 1994.

A SWIFT KICK IN THE PETRO

Senior PK **Mark Petro** has ranked among the nation's top kickers over the past two years, and is now in rare company in school history among players at his position. He now holds Hillsdale's all-time record for extra-points made with 135. His 46 field goals made in his career are second all-time to Rick Vear's 49, and Petro's 229 career points are second in school history among kickers, only trailing Charger Hall-of-Famer Chester Marcol. Petro is currently second in Division II with 2.0 field goals per game.

SECOND-GENERATION CHARGERS

Part of the great tradition of Hillsdale College football comes in the generations of players who have suited up for the Chargers. The 2009 team has three players who all had fathers that played at Hillsdale. QB **Brad Otterbein** (father Keith), DB **Joe Vear** (father Rick), and QB **Anthony Mifsud** (father David) all represent a second generation of Hillsdale College football players within their own families.

GLIAC HONORS TWO CHARGERS

For the first time in many years, two Hillsdale College football players earned GLIAC honors in the same week. Sophomore DB **Nick Hixson** was named the GLIAC Defensive Player of the Week, and senior PK **Mark Petro** was named the GLIAC Special Teams Player of the Week. Hixson had 14 total tackles and 135 kickoff return yards in the team's win over Grand Valley State. Petro, who has won the award twice this season, scored nine total points for Hillsdale in the win.

GROUND ROUND

Dating back to the Sept. 23 game vs. Indianapolis, 11 of Hillsdale's last 12 touchdowns scored as a team have come on the ground. Five different players have scored rushing TDs for the team in that span.

VINNIE, VIDI, VICI!

Senior RB **Vinnie Panizzi** is placing his name among the all-time best running backs in Charger history. Last week, he became the third player in school history to rush for 3,000 or more yards in his career. His 60 rushing yards vs. Grand Valley State give him 3,055 rushing yards for his career. He needs 341 yards to pass Phil Martin and move into second place on Hillsdale's career rushing list.

DOWNRIGHT OFFENSIVE

Dating back to the final game of the 2006 season, the Charger offense has scored 30 or more points in 20 out of the past 30 games. During those 28 games, Hillsdale has produced 12 300-yard passing games, 12 100-yard rushing games and 17 100-yard receiving games by individual players.
