#### WEEK 10 - HILLSDALE LOOKS FOR 4TH STRAIGHT WIN

This week, the red-hot Hillsdale College football team will look to put together its first four-game winning streak in 10 years when it travels to Big Rapids to take on Ferris State University for a 2 p.m. game.

#### THE SERIES

This is the 41st all-time meeting between the Chargers and Bulldogs, and the teams have played one another in each season since 1970. Hillsdale holds a 22-17-1 edge in the series, and is 3-1 vs. FSU in four meetings since 2005.

#### RADIO GAGA

Andy Brown and Dan Bisher will have the call from the Top Taggert Field press box, on 92.1-FM WCSR.

#### FOLLOW THE CHARGERS ONLINE

There are two other ways for fans to follow Charger football. Live stats are available for all home games, courtesy of PrestoSports. Real-time play-by-play and statistical screens are available through the free service, as well as a GLIAC scoreboard. In addition, B2Networks provides webcasting for all Hillsdale College home football games. Check the Hillsdale College athletic website for the links.

#### PRE-SEASON ACCOLADES

A handful of players have earned preseason accolades from various magazines and websites. Senior DE **Drew Berube** was named the Preseason Division II Defensive Player of the Year by the Consensus Draft Services. That same organization named Berube, TE **Matt Patillo** and OL **Jared Veldheer** to its preseason All-American lists.

D2football.com named Veldheer, Berube and PK **Mark Petro** to its preseason First-Team All-American list. Only Northwest Missouri State had as many as three players on that website's preseason All-American Team.

#### PRO PROSPECT

Jared Veldheer is rated as the No. 4 pro prospect according to D2football.com. Veldheer is the highest-rated GLIAC player on the website's list. Some of the NFL scouting services have Veldheer projected as a fourth-round draft pick.

#### WE'RE GOING STREAKING!

The Charger football team is on a three-game winning streak, and today, will look for number four in a row. The last time Hillsdale won four straight was in the middle of the 1999 season.

### AMONG THE NATIONAL LEADERS

Several Chargers fall among the Division II leaders in several statistical categories. Senior PK Mark Petro is tied for fifth in the nation with 1.67 field goals per game, and is 30th overall in scoring. Senior RB Vinnie Panizzi is ninth in the nation in average rushing yards per game (121.8) and is 15th overall in scoring (9.33). Senior DE Drew Berube is tied for 17th in the nation in sacks per game, and one of his primary receiving targets, senior WR A.J. Kegg, is tied for 15th in receptions per game.

### SECOND-GENERATION CHARGERS

Part of the great tradition of Hillsdale College football comes in the generations of players who have suited up for the Chargers. The 2009 team has three players who all had fathers that played at Hillsdale. QB **Brad Otterbein** (father Keith), DB **Joe Vear** (father Rick), and QB **Anthony Mifsud** (father David) all represent a second generation of Hillsdale College football players within their own families.

### DOCTOR DRE

Junior WR **Andre Holmes** was named the GLIAC Offensive Player of the Week on Monday, after an explosive performance vs. Wayne State. Holmes caught five passes for 119 yards and three touchdowns, all coming in the game's first 20 minutes. Holmes is the third different Charger player to earn GLIAC Offensive Player of the Week this season, joining QB Troy Weatherhead and RB Vinnie Panizzi.

### GLIAC ELITE

Since the start of the 2007 season, Hillsdale has the third-best overall record in the GLIAC, 22-9 overall. The Chargers are a half-game behind Saginaw Valley State for second place in the three-year aggregate conference standings.

### PUNTING IS A GOOD THING

As a team, Hillsdale ranks second in the nation in punting average, covering 36.5 yards per punt. The Division II leader in that category, Northeastern State, leads the Chargers by just one yard per punt entering play Saturday.

### TWO-DIMENSIONAL

Hillsdale's offense is both productive and unpredictable. From Sept. 16-Oct. 10, 11 of Hillsdale's 12 total touchdowns came on the ground. Over the last two games, both wins, the Chargers have thrown eight touchdown passes.

### SUCCESS ON BOTH SIDELINES

Hillsdale College head coach Keith Otterbein and offensive coordinator Barry Fagan have enjoyed success while coaching at both Hillsdale and Ferris State. Otterbein led the Bulldogs to the top of the GLIAC during his tenure from 1986-94, being named Regional Coach of the Year twice. Fagan guided a terrific offense at FSU during that same time, and in 1995, helped lead Ferris State to the national semifinals.

- ▶ Chargers head coach Keith Otterbein was the coach at Ferris State from 1986-94.
- ▶ In the last meeting between the teams at Big Rapids, FSU topped Hillsdale 44-41. It was the first time in school history the Chargers scored 40 or more points in a loss.
- ▶ Charger RB Vinnie Panizzi needs 85 yards to pass Phil Martin for second place on Hillsdale's career rushing list.

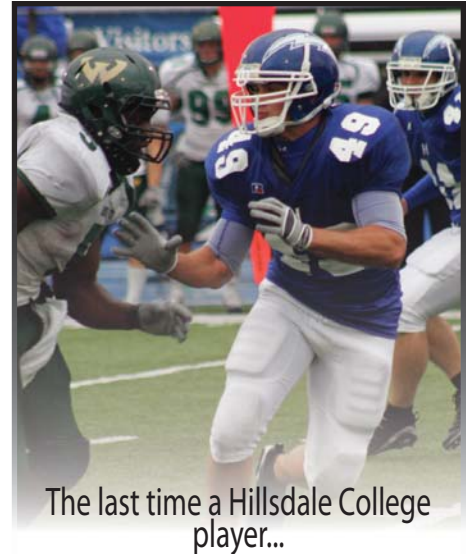
