The Hillsdale College football team brings a four-game winning streak into Saturday's home regular season finale, taking in the Tiffin University Dragons at 1 p.m.

THE SERIES

This is the sixth meeting between these schools, and the Chargers have won two straight vs. the Dragons and lead the series 3-2.

Andy Brown and Jim Eckhardt will have the call from the Muddy Waters Stadium press box, on 92.1-FM WCSR.

PRE-SEASON ACCOLADES

A handful of players have earned preseason accolades from various magazines and websites. Senior DE **Drew Berube** was named the Preseason Division II Defensive Player of the Year by the Consensus Draft Services. That same organization named Berube, TE **Matt Patillo** and OL **Jared Veldheer** to its preseason All-American lists.

D2football.com named Veldheer, Berube and PK **Mark Petro** to its preseason First-Team All-American list. Only Northwest Missouri State had as many as three players on that website's preseason All-American Team.



PRO PROSPECT

Jared Veldheer is rated as the No. 4 pro prospect according to D2football.com. Veldheer is the highest-rated GLIAC player on the website's list. Some of the NFL scouting services have Veldheer projected as a fourth-round draft pick.

WE'RE GOING STREAKING!

The Charger football team is on a four-game winning streak, and Saturday, will look for number five in a row. The last time Hillsdale won five straight was in the middle of the 1999 season.

AMONG THE NATIONAL LEADERS

Hillsdale College is well-represented as a team and individual players among the NCAA Division II statistical leaders. Hillsdale's team ranks second in the nation in net punting average, and is 14th in kickoff return yardage and 17th in points scored. Senior RB **Vinnie Panizzi** ranks ninth in average rushing yards per game and is 12th in points scored. Senior PK **Mark Petro** is fifth in field goals made, while senior DE **Drew Berube** is 13th in total sacks.

SECOND-GENERATION CHARGERS

Part of the great tradition of Hillsdale College football comes in the generations of players who have suited up for the Chargers. The 2009 team has three players who all had fathers that played at Hillsdale. QB **Brad Otterbein** (father Keith), DB **Joe Vear** (father Rick), and QB **Anthony Mifsud** (father David) all represent a second generation of Hillsdale College football players within their own families.

CLOSING IN ON SOME RECORDS

Several records are within reach of some Charger players achieving in this week's game. Senior PK **Mark Petro**, who already holds Hillsdale's career record for extra points made, can set the new career mark for field goals made with two makes. Senior WR **A.J. Kegg** is already number two on the Chargers' career receiving yards list and needs two touchdown receptions to move into fourth place on that list. Junior QB **Troy Weatherhead** is 376 passing yards shy of second place on the single-season list, and needs 33 completions to break his own single-season record in that category.

GLIAC HONOR

Freshman RB **Joe Glendening** was named the GLIAC Special Teams Player of the Week after last week's win over Ferris State. Glendening blocked a punt for a touchdown, and later scored on a two-yard run, marking his first two collegiate scores.

A POSITION OF SENORITY

In a pregame ceremony Saturday, the team's 17 seniors will be honored on the occasion of their final home regular season game. No position is as senior-heavy as the defensive line. Many of those players have started for more than three years each. The senior defensive linemen are: **Drew Berube**, **Andrew Yarbrough**, **Jordan Knudsen**, **Eric Schweller** and **Mark Yassay**.

TOUGH REGION

An easy argument could be made that Super Region 3 is by far, the best region in Division II. Four of this week's top eight teams in the AFCA Division II Top 25 poll reside in Super Region 3: Both Minnesota schools, Grand Valley State and Nebraska-Kearney. Hillsdale and Saginaw Valley are also each nationally ranked in this week's poll.

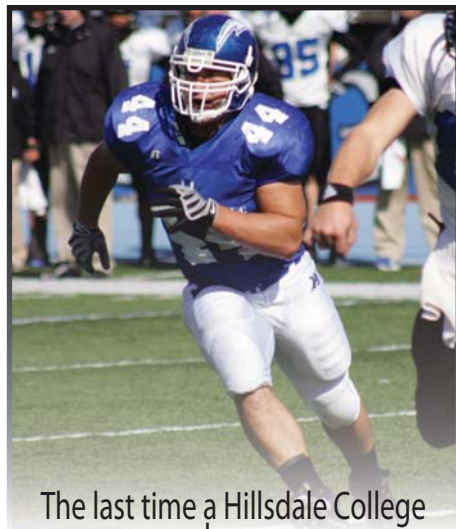

#16 - Troy Weatherhead

Leads GLIAC with 2,478 passing yards...No. 1 in GLIAC in completions with 209...Had season-high 356 passing yards in 45-14 win over Wayne State Oct. 24...Hasn't thrown an interception since Oct. 10....Holds school record for completions in a season with 242, set in 2008...Threw 4 TD passes in back-to-back games Oct. 17 and Oct. 24...Has three 300-yard passing games this season...Has also rushed for three touchdowns this season.



#22 - Vinnie Panizzi

Tied for second place on career rushing list with 3,395 yards...Is No. 2 on Hillsdale's all-time rushing touchdowns list with 47...Has six 100-yard rushing games this season...Had a season-high 231 rushing yards Sept. 23 vs. Indianapolis...Named GLIAC Offensive Player of the Week Sept. 25...Second in the GLIAC with 1,178 rushing yards and 16 touchdowns...Has 18 receptions for 117 yards on the season.



#3 - A.J. Kegg

Leads GLIAC with 65 receptions on the season...Second in Charger history with 2,156 receiving yards in his career...Has seven career 100-yard receiving games...Caught 10 passes in 45-14 win over Wayne State Oct. 24...Also has 57 rushing yards on the season...Named First-Team All-GLIAC in 2008.



#66 - Jared Veldheer

Started at left tackle in all 43 games of his career...Hasn't allowed a sack in his career...Blocked for a 1,000-yard rusher in all four seasons, and Chargers have had four of their six highest-scoring seasons in their history with Veldheer starting...Named First-Team All-GLIAC and Second-Team All-Region in 2008.

#99 - Drew Berube

Named the preseason Division II Defensive Player of the Year by Consensus Draft Services...Leads team with 10 sacks for 72 yards lost this season...Named First-Team All-GLIAC and honorable mention All-American following 2008 season...Led conference in tackles-for-loss in 2008...Had four sacks vs. Tiffin on Nov. 8, 2008...Had three tackles-for-loss at Northwood Sept. 12...Leads GLIAC with 11 sacks this season.



#4 - Mat Szula

One of the team's captains...Leads Chargers with 78 total tackles this season with 78...Had 10 solo tackles at Northwood and at Ashland...Had double digit total tackles four times this season...Has 3 1/2 tackles-for-loss...Had an 82-yard fumble return vs. Northwood on Sept. 13, 2008...Returned an interception for 40 yards at Indianapolis Sept. 20, 2008, and had a 13-yard interception return at Tiffin Nov. 8, 2008.



#36 - Nick Galvan

One of three true freshmen to crack the lineup in 2009...Started nine games at safety...Leads team with two interceptions...HYad eight or more tackles three times...Led team with 10 stops at Findlay Oct. 3...Had 43-yard fumble return at Northern Michigan Oct. 17...Leads team with 10 pass break-ups this season.



#97 - Mark Petro
