WEEK 4 - CHARGERS HOST INDIANAPOLIS UNDER THE LIGHTS

The Hillsdale College football team will play its first home night game in nearly three years when it takes on the University of Indianapolis at Frank "Muddy" Waters Stadium.

THE SERIES

This is the 26th time the Chargers and Greyhounds have battled it out on the gridiron. Hillsdale leads the all-time series 14-11, but in recent years, this series has been dead even. Neither team has won back-to-back games in this series since Indy won the matchups in 2002 and 2003.

Andy Brown and Jim Eckhardt will handle the play-by-play duties on WCSR 92.1-FM, live from the Muddy Stadium press box. Fans can also listen to the game live through a link on the Hillsdale College athletic website, www.hillsdale.edu/athletics.

PRE-SEASON ACCOLADES

A handful of players have earned preseason accolades from various magazines and websites. Senior DE **Drew Berube** was named the Preseason Division II Defensive Player of the Year by the Consensus Draft Services. That same organization named Berube, TE **Matt Patillo** and OL **Jared Veldheer** to its preseason All-American lists.

D2football.com named Veldheer, Berube and PK **Mark Petro** to its preseason First-Team All-American list. Only Northwest Missouri State had as many as three players on that website's preseason All-American Team.

PRO PROSPECT

Jared Veldheer is rated as the No. 4 pro prospect according to D2football.com. Veldheer is the highest-rated GLIAC player on the website's list.

BEWARE THE NUMBER 37

In a remarkable statistical anomaly, the Chargers have scored 37 points in four straight games, including all three this season. Hillsdale is 3-1 in those games, and three of those four games have been decided by two points or less.

SECOND-GENERATION CHARGERS

Part of the great tradition of Hillsdale College football comes in the generations of players who have suited up for the Chargers. The 2009 team has three players who all had fathers that played at Hillsdale. QB **Brad Otterbein** (father Keith), DB **Joe Vear** (father Rick), and QB **Anthony Mifsud** (father David) all represent a second generation of Hillsdale College football players within their own families.

INDIVIDUAL LEADERS

Hillsdale's offense ranks near the top of many team rankings in the conference, thanks to some excellent individual performances by some of its players. QB **Troy Weatherhead** leads the GLIAC in passing average per game and total offense, while WRs **Andre Holmes** and **A.J. Kegg** rank 1-2 in the conference with 24 catches. No one else in the GLIAC has as many as 18 receptions on the season. RB **Vinnie Panizzi's** 36 points also top the conference, and **Mike Blanchard's** 198 all-purpose yards per game also rank No. 1 in the GLIAC.

WHEN WE LAST SAW THE CHARGERS...

A back-and-forth game last Saturday ended in Hillsdale's first loss of the season, 38-37, to Northwood University in Midland. The Chargers held leads of 6-0 and 12-7 before falling behind 28-15. Hillsdale rallied to take a 37-31 lead, but could not hang onto the lead.

CLIMBING THE CHARTS

With 52 passing yards today, QB **Troy Weatherhead** will become the eighth signal-caller in school history to pass for 4,000 career yards. RB **Vinnie Panizzi** needs 26 rushing yards to become the fourth back to ever accumulate 2,500 rushing yards in a career. He needs 127 yards on the ground to reach third place on Hillsdale's career list.

MILESTONE REACHED

Hillsdale College head coach Keith Otterbein won his 100th career game on Sept. 5 in Hillsdale's 37-35 win at home over Michigan Tech. Only one other current GLIAC coach - Bernie Anderson at Northern Michigan - has as many as 100 victories in his head coaching career. Forty of Otterbein's wins have come coaching the Chargers. He racked up 60 wins in eight seasons as head coach at Ferris State.

NO MORAL VICTORIES

Dating back to the beginning of the 2007 season, seven of the Chargers' eight losses have come by seven points or less. Hillsdale is 4-7 in games decided by a touchdown or less since 2007.
