WEEK 5 - CHARGERS VISIT THE NEW DIGS AT ASHLAND UNIVERSITY

The Hillsdale College football team will become just the second team to ever play in brand-new Community Stadium in Ashland Saturday, as the Chargers travel to Ohio to take on the Eagles.

THE SERIES

This is the 40th all-time meeting between these teams, and this stands as one of the longest consecutive rivalries in the conference. Hillsdale leads the series with Ashland 22-17, but has lost four of the past five games to the Eagles.

PRE-SEASON ACCOLADES

A handful of players have earned preseason accolades from various magazines and websites. Senior DE **Drew Berube** was named the Preseason Division II Defensive Player of the Year by the Consensus Draft Services. That same organization named Berube, TE **Matt Patillo** and OL **Jared Veldheer** to its preseason All-American lists.

D2football.com named Veldheer, Berube and PK **Mark Petro** to its preseason First-Team All-American list. Only Northwest Missouri State had as many as three players on that website's preseason All-American Team.

PRO PROSPECT

Jared Veldheer is rated as the No. 4 pro prospect according to D2football.com. Veldheer is the highest-rated GLIAC player on the website's list.

ON THE ROAD...AGAIN

This week, the Chargers begin their first two-game road trip since the 2005 season. The last time Hillsdale played back-to-back road games was Oct. 22-29, 2005. Hillsdale won both of those games, 24-7 at Tiffin and 40-21 at Mercyhurst.

THE NATIONAL LEADER

Senior PK **Mark Petro** has been one of the most accurate kickers in all of Division II, and he has risen to the top of the national rankings. Petro averages 2.5 field goals per game, making him number one among all Division II kickers. Petro has split the uprights on 10-of-11 field goal tries this season, and 12-of-13 extra-point attempts. He is the only kicker in the GLIAC averaging more than 10 points per game.

SECOND-GENERATION CHARGERS

Part of the great tradition of Hillsdale College football comes in the generations of players who have suited up for the Chargers. The 2009 team has three players who all had fathers that played at Hillsdale. QB **Brad Otterbein** (father Keith), DB **Joe Vear** (father Rick), and QB **Anthony Mifsud** (father David) all represent a second generation of Hillsdale College football players within their own families.

INDIVIDUAL LEADERS

Hillsdale has put together one of the most consistent and high-scoring offenses in the GLIAC this season. Several players rank near the top of the GLIAC stats as a result of that productivity. Junior QB **Troy Weatherhead** leads the GLIAC with an average of 275 passing yards per game. The Chargers have the top two receivers in the conference, with **A.J. Kegg** (7.5) and **Andre Holmes** (7.2) leading the GLIAC in average receptions per game. Holmes is second in the conference in average receiving yards per game and is one of three wide receivers in the league averaging more than 100 yards per game. Junior **Mike Blanchard** is the GLIAC leader in both average punt return yards (12.2) and average kick return yardage (26.4).

WHEN WE LAST SAW THE CHARGERS...

Hillsdale recorded its first shutout in nearly two years in a 23-0 win over the University of Indianapolis last weekend. In the first night game at Muddy Waters Stadium in three years, the Chargers earned a second consecutive win over the Greyhounds for the first time since 1995-1996.

CLIMBING THE CHARTS

Troy Weatherhead became the eighth quarterback in school history to pass for more than 4,000 yards in a career last week vs. Indianapolis. In less than two full seasons as a starter, Weatherhead has thrown for 4,084 yards, ranking him seventh on Hillsdale's all-time list. He needs 162 passing yards to move into sixth place on the Chargers' career list.

MILESTONE REACHED

Hillsdale College head coach Keith Otterbein won his 100th career game on Sept. 5 in Hillsdale's 37-35 win at home over Michigan Tech. Only one other current GLIAC coach - Bernie Anderson at Northern Michigan - has as many as 100 victories in his head coaching career. Forty-one of Otterbein's wins have come coaching the Chargers. He racked up 60 wins in eight seasons as head coach at Ferris State.

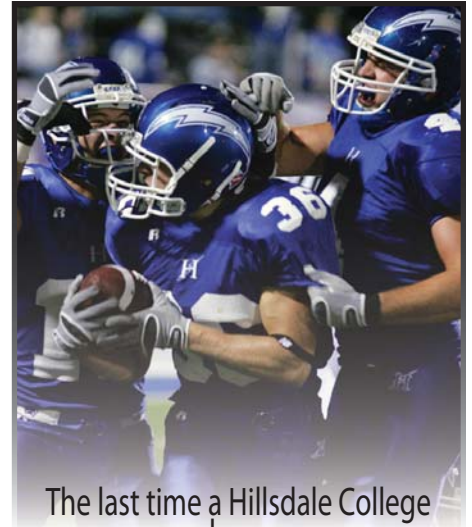
