Week 2 - Chargers look for 2-0 start vs. Wildcats

Coming off one of its most lopsided wins ever, the Hillsdale College football team seeks its first 2-0 start since 1999 in today's GLIAC game vs. Northern Michigan University.

The Series

This will be the 36th meeting all-time between the Chargers and Wildcats. Hillsdale leads the series 20-14-1, although Northern Michigan won the last meeting between the teams, 31-24, Sept. 9, 2006 at Muddy Waters Stadium. The last time Hillsdale beat NMU was during the 2003 season, when the Chargers earned a 27-20 victory.

Media Coverage

WCSR-92.1 FM Hillsdale will pick up the live radio feed from Northern Star Broadcasting, with John Focke handling play-by-play duties. B2Networks will also be webcasting the game. Check the Northern Michigan University athletic website for details.

Historic Win

The Week 1 victory by Hillsdale over Gannon resonated within the 116-year history of Charger football. The 59-3 final score was the most lopsided win for Hillsdale since the 1969 season, and the 59 points scored were the most since a 68-point tally vs. Northwood in 1968. Mark Nicolet's five touchdown passes were one shy of the school record set by Kyle Keefer on Oct. 9, 1999, when he threw six vs. Mercyhurst. The eight extra-points kicked by kicker Mark Petro were also one shy of the school record, set by Chester Marcol on Sept. 18, 1970.

Local Service

There are seven players on the Charger roster from Hillsdale High School - Joe Vear, Mike Blanchard, Brad Otterbein, Cody Calligan, Nate English, Gage Frosch and Drew Berube. All played at Hillsdale High School under head coach Marc Lemerand. Hillsdale is the most-represented hometown of any on the roster. Five players are from Northville, Mich., on the west side of Wayne County in suburban Detroit.

Most Valuable Position

Junior linebacker Tom Korte was named the Chargers' most valuable player after the 2006 season. Hillsdale has a history of linebackers garnering MVP honors over the years. Past Roy Beck Award winners (MVP) at linebacker include: Kurt Norman, Rodney Patterson, Jerry Klekotka, Scott Duncan, Tony Scott, Matt Baltzer and Josh Mott.

Lake Orion connection

For the second straight week, the Chargers face a team with a Lake Orion (Mich.) High School graduate on the coaching staff. Jim Couretas (Class of 2002) serves as Northern Michigan's strength and conditioning coach. Gannon features Mike Crawford (Class of 2000) on its coaching staff as a grad assistant. Charger defensive back Palmer Schoening is also a Lake Orion High School graduate.

Last Matchup

The 2006 home opener finished on a downer for the Chargers, as Northern Michigan rallied from an early 14-0 deficit to upend Hillsdale 31-24, at Muddy Waters Stadium. Wildcat quarterback Buddy Rivera played a fabulous game, throwing for 249 yards and three touchdowns to lead the comeback victory. Each team had 17 first downs, while the Chargers rushed for 212 yards as a team, compared to 126 for NMU. The two teams combined for 771 yards in total offense. Hillsdale led the game 14-7 at halftime, only to see the Wildcats score 24 second-half points.

Recent Week 2 Games

Week 2 has not been kind to the Chargers in recent years. Hillsdale has lost five straight Week 2 matchups, dating back to a 21-14 win over Northwood in 2001. Findlay and Indianapolis each beat Hillsdale twice in the second week of the season, and in 2006, Northern Michigan handed the Chargers their only home loss of the season, 31-24, on Sept. 9, 2006.

Longevity

Head coach Keith Otterbein enters his sixth season as head coach today. That makes him just the fourth coach in the 116-year history of Hillsdale College football to hold the head coaching position for a sixth consecutive season. The other three are all members of the Hillsdale College Athletic Hall of Fame: Dwight Harwood (1927-48), Frank "Muddy" Waters (1954-73) and Dick Lowry (1980-96).

Coaching staff changes

Some old and new faces appear on the Hillsdale College 2007 coaching roster. After one season away from the team, Dr. John Willson is back, coaching the team's kickers. Dr. Willson is a member of the Hillsdale College Athletic Hall of Fame (Class of 2005) and has many years' experience on the Hillsdale staff. Pat Hornak resumes his duties as Director of Football Operations for a second season in 2007, but this year, will coach the Chargers' H-backs and tight ends. Joining the Charger staff for the first time this season is Scott Campbell, who will coach the team's wide receivers. Campbell works at the college's motor pool and previously coached at nearby Jonesville High School.

50th anniversary of the 1957 'Dales

The 2007 season marks the 50th anniversary of one of Hillsdale's most beloved athletic teams in its history. The 1957 football team finished the season 9-1, allowing a total of 49 points in 10 games. Doug Maison and Dave Trippett were named NAIA All-Americans that season, and the Dales won their third straight MIAA championship. Hillsdale lost to Pittsburg State 27-26 in a thrilling NAIA National Championship Game that was nationally telecast. The team had an undefeated regular season for the third straight time, and its record 34-game winning streak came to an end with that title game loss. The 34-game winning streak still stands today as a national record.
